Peace Peace Peace*

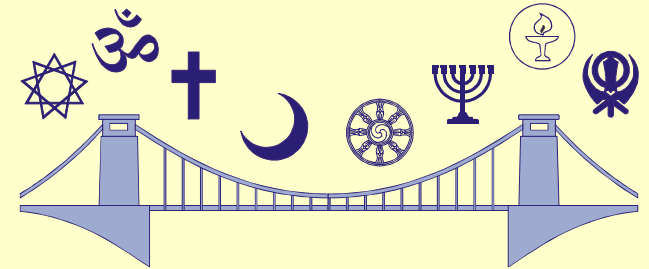
